Blue Mountain Recreation Commission Biddy Wrestling Program

Practice Location: High School Wrestling Room

Home Matches: Primarily held at the high school on Sunday afternoons.

As the season progresses, detailed schedules for all matches will be provided to parents.

The high school is a busy facility, hosting interscholastic sporting events, booster activities, meetings, special events, and a variety of school activities. All school activities have priority use of the building. Please review the following expectations for the Blue Mountain High School:

<u>Access & Parking</u>

- Entrance: The Biddy Wrestling program will ONLY use the front doors near the auditorium for entering and exiting the building during practices.
 - Parents, guardians, siblings, and wrestlers should use this entrance **ONLY**.
 - Parking is available in the front or side lot near the auditorium.
- **Restricted Access:** All other areas of the school, including the auxiliary gym, locker rooms, and hallways, are offlimits to Biddy Wrestlers and accompanying family members.
 - Unauthorized individuals in these areas will be considered trespassing and may face disciplinary action.
- Waiting Area: The designated waiting area is the foyer to the left of the entrance doors. Wrestlers will access the wrestling room via the stairs in this foyer.
- **On-Site Assistance:** The Blue Mountain Recreation Commission will have an Attendant on duty if any questions arise.

<u>Biddy Wrestling Rules</u>

1. Arrival & Supervision:

- Parents should bring their children into the building no more than 10 minutes before their scheduled practice time.
- \circ Parents must supervise their children until the coaches escort them to the wrestling room.
- Students must remain in the foyer area until they are escorted by the coaching staff.

2. Restricted Access to the Wrestling Room:

- Access is restricted to wrestlers, staff, and coaches only. Parents and family members must remain downstairs in the foyer area.
- Only individuals with proper clearances are permitted upstairs, where the wrestling room is located.
- A potential observation day for parents may be arranged, but due to space limitations, regular access to the wrestling room is not allowed.

3. Wrestling Room Rules:

- **Street shoes** are NOT permitted in the wrestling room to prevent damage to the mats. Wrestling shoes are to be carried to and from practice, not worn.
- Wrestlers and coaches must bring a clean pair of shoes to wear in the wrestling room.
- No food or drink is allowed, except for water in plastic bottles. Note: Water ONLY—sports drinks, soda, and juice can damage the mats.

4. Supervision of Siblings:

- \circ $\;$ It is recommended that parents avoid bringing other children if waiting during practice times.
- All children must remain in the foyer area and be <u>supervised at all times</u>.
- \circ $\;$ Horseplay, running, playing, or leaving the foyer area is not permitted for safety reasons.

5. Sunday Home Matches:

- Matches will start at 1:00 p.m.
- No children are allowed in school buildings on Sundays before 12:00 noon. This is a strict school policy with no exceptions.

The Blue Mountain Recreation Commission staff works hard to ensure that the children enjoy a quality recreation program. With cooperation from parents, we can start programs on time and ensure that every child has a safe and fun wrestling season. By following these rules, we can make the most of the state-of-the-art facility and minimize any potential issues.
